All entrants to NSW Championships events must compete in at least two competitions (international, national, club, state or other) between each year's State Championships. The competitions must have the same technical requirements as NSW Championships and may incorporate Short Program and/or Free Skating for Singles, Pairs and Synchronized Teams and one or two Compulsory Dances and/or Original Dance and/or Free Dance for Dance couples. In the case of illness or injury precluding two competitions during the twelve month period, athletes may be required to produce a medical certificate from a qualified medical practitioner.

### COMPETITOR'S CODE of ETHICS and CHAMPIONSHIPS RULES:

All skaters entering the Championships must adhere to the following, and agree that they will at all times:

1. *Observe the rules of the New South Wales Ice Skating Association Incorporated, including the code of behaviour as detailed in the Members Protection Policy.*
2. *Behave in a sportsman-like manner, both on and off the ice.*
3. *Show proper courtesy to all judges, officials, guests and spectators.*
4. *Do nothing to distract another skater, either deliberately or inadvertently.*
5. *Not obstruct spectator view of the skaters.*
6. *Always promote the sport of Ice Skating and the Association affairs.*
7. *For the duration of the Championships, refrain from supplying any information to the media, either spoken or written, without the approval of the NSWISA or designated officers.*
8. *Co-operate with all promotional activities as determined by the Association.*
9. *I acknowledge the video and photographic regulations for the Championships detailed in the announcement and agree to allow NSWISA to use photographs/video footage of me taken at sanctioned events for promotional material as detailed in the bye-laws.*
10. *Any parent who wishes that their child or children not be filmed must advise the organizing committee prior to the commencement of Championships.*
11. *Provide cd's clearly labelled and containing one program music only.*
12. *Be present in appropriate costume and boots for presentations. Trophies, certificates will not be available in other circumstances.*

*Note: Nothing to be thrown on the ice. Flowers, etc. may be handed to competitors as they leave the ice.*
