All sections of the forms <u>must be completed</u> (including POA). <i>Incomplete entry forms will be returned to the skater for completion with a \$50 penalty (NSW Championship forms may be used for entry to Nationals. Entry without music details or PPC <u>will not be accepted</u>.</i>

All NSWISA members competing in Championship events must compete in at least two competitions (International, National, Club, State or other) between each year's State Championships. The competitions must have the same technical requirements as NSW Championships and may incorporate Short Program and/or Free Skating for Singles, Pairs and Synchronised Teams and one or two Pattern Dances and/or Free Dance for Pre-Primary, Primary & Novice Dance couples, and Short Dance and/or Free Dance for Junior & Senior Dance couples.

For those who do not meet the above eligibility requirements written application should be made with the entry for consideration by the Championship Committee.

- The decisions of the Referees and the Organising Committee will be final in all matters pertaining to the conduct of the Championships.
- Ice resurfaces will be as required by the Referee in consultation with the NSWISA Event Co-ordinator.
- Applications to enter the Championships will be deemed as acceptance by skater/parent/guardian/coach of the rules and conditions established by NSWISA Inc.
- While all possible checks for eligibility of skaters will be carried out by NSWISA the onus is on the skater to enter the correct division according to the criteria set by NSWISA Inc and the requirements of the ISA Regulations.

Technical Requirements to follow – (In accordance with ISA Regulations and applicable ISA Communications published on <u>www.isa.org.au</u> and ISU Regulations & applicable ISU Communications published on <u>www.isu.org</u>.)

Test Levels:	As at close of entries (no test pending)	
Proof of Age:	All competitors must be registered on the ISA Proof of Age register by the closing date.	
Draws:	The draw will be on Sunday 28th September 2014, 4.30pm at Canterbury Ice Rink Canteen.	
Music:	Programs will be skated to music of the skater's choice and must comply with ISU requirements for music as applicable to Singles/Pairs/Dance & Synchronized. Music <u>MUST</u> be on a CD – only 1 track per CD. All CDs <u>MUST</u> be clearly marked with the competitor's name, event and music time. <i>CD's must be of good quality and submitted in a separate case for each CD. An additional CD must be submitted at the time of registration in order to be on hand should a problem occur with the program CD.</i> Music may be retrieved from the Registration Desk after the event.	
Registration:	The official registration desk will be located near the main entrance. Competitors must check in <u>1 hour</u> before the event.	
Marking:	The International Judging System will be used for all divisions.	
PPC Form:	A Planned Program Content form for each event <u>must be lodged with the entry</u> <u>form</u> for all competitors in all divisions or the <u>entry will not be processed</u> . Please see the latest ISU Communications for updated abbreviations for elements.	
Tickets:	\$2 adult / \$1 children and concession holders free.	
Chaperones:	One per skater in Singles, Pairs and Dance. One pass for each Synchronized skater competing only in Synchronized events. Where a Synchronized skater is involved in

more than 1 team, only 1 pass will be issued. (Synchronized chaperone passes will only be valid for Synchronized events).

- Withdrawals: Refund only with medical certificate a 15% deduction from the entry fee before the draw and no refund available after the draw.
- **Medals/Trophies:** Medals will be awarded to the first three placegetters in each event. Perpetual Trophies will be retained by NSWISA at Sports House and will be engraved with the winner's name.
- **Presentation:** Presentation of trophies and medals will take place on the night each division is completed.
- **Photography:** An official photographer will be taking photos at the Championships. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase. For private photographers, please note that <u>no flash photography</u> is allowed in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters. All private photographers are required to register at the Information/Registrations desk on the day of the event.
- Video Permits: The permit is free of charge and will be available at the registration desk or the administration office. Permit holders will only be permitted to video their child in their event; parents may obtain a permit to allow the videotaping of their child by a third party. A designated area will be set aside for the use of video and camera equipment. NSWISA reserves the right to expel persons who do not comply with the established rules. Anyone wishing to take still photographs will also be required to sign an application. No photography or videoing will be permitted at any practice session.
